Scholastically, you are eligible to be considered for selection to the Minnesota Honor Society. National Honor Society membership is based on four criteria: **Scholarship, Service, Leadership, and Character**. If you are interested in becoming a member, please complete *all sections* of the student activity information form. Completion of this form must include documentation in each area, an essay, and a teacher recommendation.

This needs to be completed by 3:00 pm on Tuesday, February 6, 2017. To access the form, you will need to:

1. Go to 549online.org
 2. Download the MHS form, off the front page of Moodle
 3. Once complete, you will need to upload it on the front page of Moodle for submission.

1. Remember to ask someone for your recommendation as soon as you can. The person completing this recommendation should give it directly to Lynn in the office, (MHS applicant does not see the review)
 2. Reminder...completion of this form does not guarantee selection; it is merely an application that qualifies you for a formal review. The formal review process is conducted by the Minnesota Honor Society Faculty Council. They base selection to MHS on review of your student activity information form, and other verifiable information - which may include tardiness, absenteeism, and other school violations.
 3. You will be notified by US mail (and email) once the committee has made their selections, which will include a congratulations letter, and a formal invite to the induction ceremony.
 4. If for some reason the faculty council decides against your application to MHS, you will have an opportunity to meet with Mr. Zimmerman to go over any concerns you may have.
